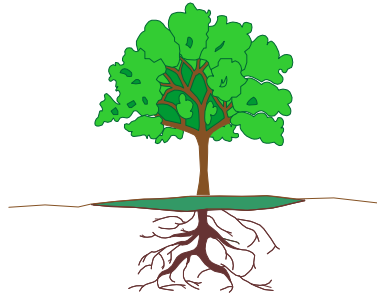

Australia, WWI Service Records, 1914-1920. This collection includes service dossiers for Australians who served in the First World War and features more than 12 million images and 375,000 records.

Australia, Imperial Force Burials at Gallipoli, 1915. This collection includes records of soldiers of the Australian Imperial Force (AIF) who died at Gallipoli in WWI. You'll find a digital database of service records, plus digital images of portraits, headstones, and memorials

UK, Royal Navy Registers of Seamen's Services, 1900-1928. These registers record the service of seamen in the Royal Navy from 1900 through 1928. Records include birth date, birthplace, vessels served on, and dates of service.
